The Units

Entry Requirements



For entry onto the OTHM Level 7 Postgraduate Diploma in Data Science qualification, learners must possess:

- Applicants should hold a Bachelor's degree or an equivalent qualification in a related field such as Business, Management, or Engineering.
- Ideally, candidates should have a minimum of two years of professional experience in project management or a related field.
- Non-native English speakers need to demonstrate English proficiency with an IELTS score of 6.0 or equivalent.
- Candidates over 21 years of age, without formal qualifications, significant work experience and relevant professional certifications may be considered for admission.
